



WHAT IS THE **ACTUAL PRICE** OF PRODUCING A TEXTILE?

- high water and energy consumption
- water and soil pollution
- a decline in biodiversity
- greenhouse gases

HOW TO **AVOID IT?**

- buy less clothes – ask yourself if you really need new clothes, only buy clothes that you actually need
- buy second-hand clothes take good care of your clothes, mend them if they are worn out
- recycle your used clothes
- bring clothes not suitable for recycling to a waste station



In Estonia, each person generates 17 kg of textile waste per year, out of which less than 1 kg is recycled. The remaining waste is taken to a landfill or waste incineration plants.
